School Goals

Tennessee Middle School's goal is to meet all students where they are currently and help them grow academically as far as possible during their time with us! We will focus on providing a safe and secure learning environment, create a positive school culture, and deliver high-quality instruction. This focus will help support our students as they prepare to become ready for post-graduate success. Specific school goals include: Maintain or decrease the percentile rank of students performing at Level 1 (Below) on standardized testing, maintain or improve the number of students performing at Level 3 (meets expectations) or Level 4 (exceeds expectations) on standardized testing, achieve or exceed a level 3 TVAAS composite score, and to be clearly focused on every student growing at least one year academically during the school year of 2023-2024.

Teachers will ensure that...

- We will promote a positive and safe learning environment and administer conduct standards consistently.
- TMS will monitor attendance and notify the family if there are attendance and/or tardy issues.

Families will ensure that...:
